Monthly CEO calls

We hold monthly CEO calls where the sector comes together to share intelligence and challenges and hear more from Bond about the issues facing the sector. You will be contacted directly with the dates and times for these. These calls are held on Zoom to help everyone to take part.

CEO forum

This is closed door, face-to-face peer level discussion on the strategic challenges facing the sector. Facilitated by expert contributors and speakers, these sessions focus on the hot button, big picture issues of the moment. It supports senior leaders in the sector to hold space for strategic thinking and creative problem solving that many of the topics require. You'll also hear about these directly and we encourage you to book your place quickly as they do tend to be very well attended.

Meetings with Government

Bond will convene the sector and make invitations to attend Government level meetings. When this happens, you will be asked if you are able to attend. We try to vary the organisations in attendance as much as we can. These meetings are often arranged at short notice, and your prompt response will be required to secure a place.
